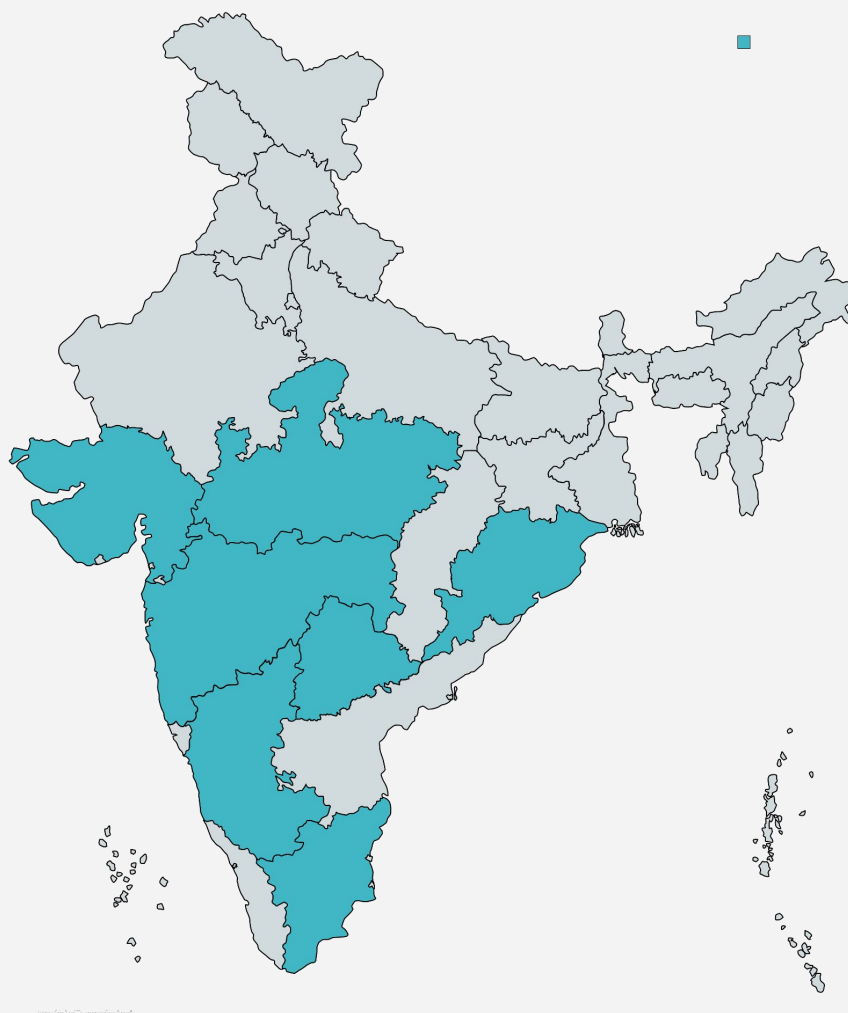

2023 was yet again another fantastic year. Once more, our athletes, coaches, team members, and partners significantly played a part in strengthening the foundation's vision.

January
